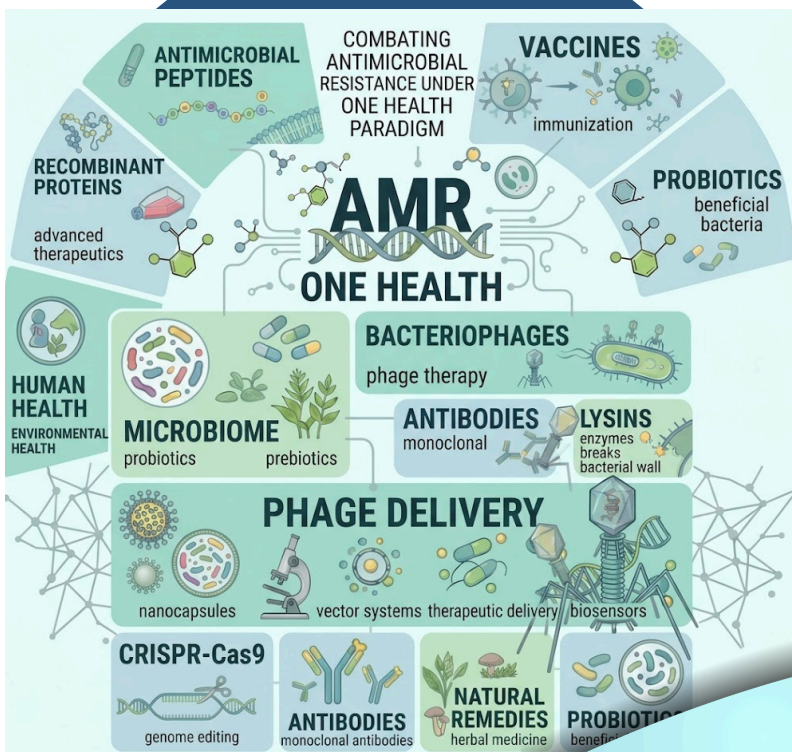
National Centre for Veterinary Type Cultures (NCVTC) ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines

NCVTC is a national microbial repository under the aegis of ICAR located at ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (ICAR-NRCE), Hisar, Haryana for the conservation of animal microbial diversity across the country. The microbial collection includes: bacteria, viruses, bacteriophages, cell lines, clones and fungi of veterinary, rumen and dairy origin. The institute harbours state-of-art laboratories for working on pathogenic microbes, a Centre of Excellence on Genome Editing, a BSL-3+ facility for handling highly pathogenic transmissible microbes and two small animal houses. There are three OIE-certified laboratories (Equine influenza, Glanders and Babesia), one WOH- certified laboratory and NBA accredited NCVTC repository which functions under ISO 2009 format. NCVTC also has the ICAR supported-National Fellow Laboratory on Bacteriophages-The First National Bacteriophage Bank under ICAR for conducting the research on bacteriophages.

SBRT was founded in 2017 and officially registered on 19 December 2018. The Society for Bacteriophage Research and Therapy is committed to advancing the study and application of bacteriophages, with a primary focus on tackling antimicrobial resistance (AMR). The society maintains high standards, featuring research on viable options for overcoming AMR and hosts technical conferences, seminars, and workshops across various regions of the country to bridge the gap between research and practical applications. Its flagship event, the International Conference (ICBRAR) is held annually.

Abstract submission guidelines: The abstract must be written in English and should not exceed 250 words. It should be presented as a single paragraph without subheadings. Conference abstracts should be prepared in Times New Roman, 12-point font, with single spacing, and justified alignment. The title should be in bold and centered, followed by the names of authors and their affiliations, with the presenting author and corresponding author indicated with * and ** respectively. The abstract should present original research with at least preliminary results, and the content should briefly cover the background, methodology, key results, and conclusion of the study. The final document should be submitted in the word as well as PDF format.
